- 1 Cancer recurrence should be suspected in any cancer patient with new pain, even if the patient is presumed to be in remission.
- 2 Pain specialists often follow patients more frequently primary oncology team when disease is assumed to be stable, and are uniquely positioned to detect early recurrence.
